

May 12, 2024 ASCENSION OF THE LORD Today's Focus: Get to Work!

There are plenty of things in this life that can occupy our time without really accomplishing anything, whether alone or with others. Eventually, however, the time comes to get to work!

FIRST READING: Acts 1:1-11

How ought we live in light of Jesus' apparent absence? This is no hypothetical but a question that perplexed the early church and that the Acts account of the Ascension attempts to answer. Addressed to Theophilus, literally friend or beloved of God, it concludes with the apostles gawking at Jesus' absence. The two men's response recalls the advice Jesus gives earlier, namely, to wait. This is no inert waiting. Though the apostle knows neither the times nor the seasons, "through the Holy Spirit" they will be agents of Jesus' work "to the ends of the earth." We might hear this text as addressed to us, who as God's friends can trust divine plans even though mysterious. Our Spirit-empowered waiting can entail active witnessing with our own lives and words to the Good News.

SECOND READING: Ephesians 4:1-13 [4:1-7,11-13]

Our second reading briefly references Jesus' ascension and connects it to his descent, that is, to his life on earth. The purpose of Jesus' spatial presence on earth and then through and "far above all the heavens" is cosmic, "that he might fill all things." Our reading opens with Paul identifying himself as incarcerated, as bound by chains. He urges his audience to a life informed by virtue and bound together with others in peace. Ephesians imagines a diversity of gifts but all in the service of unity. The life of faith should not atomize us but should draw us together into community with all people, and as Ephesians' cosmic vision seems to suggest, with all creation because God is "over all and through all and in all."

GOSPEL: Mark 16:15-20

As we recall from our Easter Sunday reflections, most scholars believe that Mark originally ended at 16:8, perhaps as a way of maintaining focus on the suffering that the life of faith surely entails without passing too quickly to the joy of resurrection. It is likely that editors, perhaps drawing from other Gospels, added the concluding verses to make Mark more palatable. Strikingly, Jesus' commission is to announce the good news "to every creature" and not just to "all nations" as in Matthew and Luke. The verses about snakes and deadly drinks are odd. Surely Jesus is not urging us to test God by seeking out snakes and poison, but to trust God in the face of potentially lethal adversity. Our reading concludes with ebullience (lively & enthusiastic). As Jesus ascends, the disciples disperse to preach "everywhere," accompanied by God, who can be trusted.
